


Welcome to the Edson Food Bank Society

We have been operating since 1981. We currently help serve close to 200 families per month with our supplementary hamper program - which provides 10-14 days worth of food.

Hamper building

We host work bees twice per week. During these 90 minute sessions, our volunteers build 12-30 non-perishable hampers for the week ahead. Each hampe consists of an 'A' box and a 'B' box with a 3rd 'C' box for larger families of 5+ people. Contents vary in quantity based on family.

2 Bags of Carrots








Birthday Bags are donated to us by a local school union, most recently Westhaven School

Drop off bin locations









- We have work bees every Mon. & Thurs. 9:30am-11am, where we plan and pack our hampers.
- We're open to clients every Tues. a.m. and have various positions available-including client intake, bulk room sorting, produce hamper building, bakery pickup and more!
- If you're a night owl, we are open 2 Thurs. evenings/month until 8pm with client facing and behind the scenes options.
- If you're a lone wolf and want to help by picking up deliveries, we have options for that, too!

Food waste and our farms program

We pride ourselves on being very close to zero waste. Any food that is unable to be consumed safely- it's past it's shelf life, has been damaged or opened - is distributed to our farm program. We also adhere closing to the Edson organics bin program.



Food Recovery and Reclamation

We are able to receive produce, meat, dairy, non perishables and some non food items for free through our food reclamation process. We have partnerships with WalMart, Sobeys, Shoppers Drug Mart and Independent Grocers which allows us to receive their short dated or overstock products!
